JOINT SCHOOL COMMITTEE
POWERS, RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

The Union 69 School Committee will meet the first Monday of December (or at a date in December mutually agreed upon by the three school committees) for the purpose of evaluation/employment of the Superintendent and budget adoption for the central office.

Sub Committees may be formed to address coordination of policy, curriculum, instructional methodology and other areas as identified across the three towns.

Special Joint Committee Meetings may be called at the request of any Chair in consultation with the Superintendent of Schools. Joint Board meetings will rotate among the three towns.

At the December meeting the election of a Joint Board Chair, Vice-Chair and Secretary shall occur for the upcoming year.

Eight School Committee members with at least two Appleton School Committee members, two Hope School Committee members and 2 Lincolnville Committee members will constitute a quorum. A weighted vote of 2.509 will be necessary in order to pass a motion based on the 2010 census counts for the three towns (Appleton: 1,316, Hope: 1,536 and Lincolnville: 2,164
