

SCHOOL SUPERINTENDENT

A primary function of School Union 69 is to select a Superintendent of Schools. To select a Superintendent, a majority vote of all members of the Union Committee shall be required. He/she may be appointed to a contract of up to five years in accordance with the laws of the state of Maine.

The Superintendent shall be executive officer of School Union 69 and its respective three School Committees. In addition, under Maine Statutes he/she shall serve as secretary ex officio to each School Committee. He/she shall attend all meetings and have the right to speak on all subjects, but shall have no vote.

The Superintendent shall administer and supervise the public educational system of each town. He/she shall have discretionary authority, subject to later approval by the School Committee, to act upon all emergency matters and those as to which his/her power and duties are not specifically set forth or limited.

The Superintendent shall devote his/her entire contracted time to the duties of the position.
