

### EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLANS

School Union 69 schools strongly disapprove of any action by any person or event that seriously disrupts the educational process. In the event an emergency evacuation is required, the following guidelines will be followed:

1. The building Principal or designee and the Superintendent of Schools will be notified immediately.
2. Emergency response personnel will be notified.
3. Students and staff will evacuate the building according to a plan designed by the Principal/designee.
4. The building and/or premises will be inspected under the direction of a previously designated fire and/or police official in conjunction with school personnel.
5. If a thorough inspection has been conducted and no danger exists, the feasibility of returning students and personnel to the building will be evaluated by a previously designated fire or police official, subject to final approval by the Principal/designee.
6. Students who leave school without permission will be subject to discipline.
7. Investigations will be made by school officials and law enforcement/fire departments in cooperation with other appropriate agencies as warranted.
