Re: Principal's Report

1. Facilities/Maintenance:

a. The sign has been repaired and is back in place

- b. G&E Roofing placed several patches on the roof over Walsh Common. There are signs of extensive degradation that need further investigation. I have asked G&E to access the condition and make recommendations. I have attached photos.
- c. HVAC systems repairs and updates continue to progress. All of the heat recovery wheels have been replaced. Most of the components that should be reporting are online and working.
- d. The bottle shed donated by the eighth grade class of 2018 has been ordered and should be delivered any day. It will be placed between the fence and Lynx Lane.
- e. Weather stripping has been repaired or replaced on all exterior doors.

2. Food Service:

a. We received a notice from Emily Walters, Director of Let's Go congratulating LCS and our food service staff for achieving 2019 Let's Go! Smarter Lunchroom recognition. This recognition program honors school lunchrooms that are implementing best practices that reduce waste and increase participation. Many of the low-to-no cost environmental changes that have been made help nudge students to make healthier choices. The award singled out the efforts of Angela Wheaton who oversees the program here at LCS.

3. Fall Sports:

- a. The cross country season is over. The LCS boys finished in second place overall at the recent Busline League Championship Meet. The girls finished in third. Jaden Johnson took top honors as the girls individual champion for the second year in a row. She finished her LCS XC career with 12 consecutive wins!
- b. Our soccer team enters the playoffs as the number one seed after another very successful regular season.

4. Fall Assessments:
