1. Facilities/Maintenance:

- a. I met with Mitch Daigle to schedule the work listed above. All of it was budgeted for completion this year. We held off on scheduling it until after the larger items were completed and cleared the warrant as a precautionary measure.
- b. As directed by the state Public Water System Inspector, I developed a Cross Connection Control Plan as required. We need to have this plan in place because our drinking water has a connection to our sprinkler system. The two systems are linked by a backflow prevention valve, which is inspected regularly by Maine Fire Prevention. We are now fully in compliance.
- c. I have scheduled to have the browntail moth nests removed from the oak trees on the front lawn.

2. Activities:

- a. Our middle school chorus, stage band, and concert band concert was a big success in that it was played in front of a packed house, extremely well performed and directed, and resulted in a high volume of positive feedback. In short – it was a great show!
- b. Both of our basketball teams have completed their seasons, both at the hands of our friends from Hope. It was a joy to witness the high level of sportsmanship displayed by our athletes this year both in victory and defeat.

3. Budget:
