


The Lincolnville School Committee met on Monday, August 11, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. in the Library at Lincolnville Central School and via Zoom.

Present were: Jared Harbaugh, John Williams, Tracee O'Brien, Matt Powers, and Mike Johnson (via Zoom).

Also present were Superintendent Kathryn Clark, and principal Paul Russo (via Zoom).

1. Call to Order- Tracee O'Brien called the meeting to order at 6:04
2. Public Comment-none
3. Adjustments to the agenda-none
4. Vote: Delay School Opening for students to September 8, 2020.
Teachers would return on and prepare for reopening schools during COVID 19 pandemic prior to student arrival. Mr. Russo explained the rationale for this change and the new calendar, which does not impact the number of days students would attend school. Teacher workshop days that were previously scheduled throughout the year have been reassigned to the beginning of the school year before students arrive. This time allows for teachers to develop instructional practices related to teaching remotely or in a hybrid format, time for trainings and time for the school team to work out details and logistics before students are in the building.
Vote: Jared Harbaugh made a motion to approve the change in the calendar, Matt Powers seconded the motion. Vote: 5-0 in favor, motion carried.
5. Items for the Next Agenda. Meeting date: Emergency Meeting to vote on school reopening plan
6. Adjournment : Jared Harbaugh moved to adjourn the meeting, the motion was seconded by Matt Powers. Vote 5-0, meeting was adjourned at 6:26 pm
